Minutes of Meeting: September 14, 2022

Peter Johnson opened the meeting at 7:05 PM

1) <u>Review/Approval Meeting Minutes</u>: Meeting minutes of the 07/11/22 HHC meeting were reviewed and approved. Chris Haraden will post them to the HHC town website.

2) <u>733 Main St- Update:</u> The October 3rd meeting between David Degetto and the Selectboard has been postponed. The purpose of this meeting was to review the Town's conditions and stipulations related to David's proposed move of the 733 Main structure to its new location on Union St. David had only recently seen the latest draft conditions proposed by various Town Departments and he needed more time to discuss them with his riggers, insurance providers, etc. before responding to the Town. David also needs to get a firm commitment from the cable companies (Verizon and Comcast) that they can support a timely move of the structure.

Given the <u>potential</u> barriers above (i.e. impractical conditions placed by the Town and/or inability to get needed support from the cable companies), David is considering another approach which would involve dismantling the 733 Main St. structure in place and then rebuilding it at the Union St. site.

3) CPA-supported projects for 2023 Town Meeting:

<u>Town Weights & Measures scale:</u> We believe it's appropriate that this restoration project is funded by CPA. Caleb agreed to draft the CPA funding proposal for this project. We can review the draft at our next meeting so it can be submitted prior to the CPA deadline of October 28th.

<u>Center Cemetery Crypt restoration</u>; Judy offered to find out who owns these crypts (i.e. whether the Town owns them or respective families own them). This must be known before we propose any CPC-funded work on the crypts.

4) <u>Update: Historic Resources Survey-Phase3:</u> No update available.
