

# *Community Preservation Committee*

**August 13, 2014 – 7:00 P.M.**

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The following minutes are from the meeting of the Hanover Community Preservation Committee held Wednesday August 13, 2014. The meeting was held in Hanover Town Hall.

The following Committee members were present: Diane Campbell, Wally Kemp, William Scarpelli, John Goldthwait, Jonathan Chu, and Richard Deluca.

The Chairwoman Diane Campbell opened the meeting at 7:00 p.m. Diane Campbell took time to thank Wally Kemp for his years of service on the CPC Board. Wally is stepping down and will be replaced by Mary Dun from the Open Space Committee.

The Committee reviewed the minutes from April 9, 2014 and May 5, 2014 CPC meetings. Jonathan Chu made a motion to accept the minutes from April 9 and May 5 as amended. John Goldthwait seconded the motion. All others voted in favor.

The CPC was briefed by Associate Planner; Peter Matchak on ongoing CPC funded projects:

Cemetery Final Phase BID

Habitat for Humanity/ 645 Center Street

Hal Thomas of the Open Space Committee along with other Open Space Board members presented the final Open Space / Trail Map to the CPC. This project was funded by CPC moneys approved at the 2013 Annual Town Meeting. CPC members applauded the hard work of the Open Space committee.

2015 CPC Applications:

The Board reviewed the revised 2015 CPC application and selected November 14, 2014 as the date CPC applications are to be due.

The Board heard informal presentations from the Maryann Brink representing the Historical Society. The Historical Society presented a draft application for the restoration of a 1727 medical bag and a preservation of Hanover's original engine 1 horse drawn fire engine. Additionally, the Historical Committee is proposing to develop an oral history recording project which would look to interview longtime residents of Hanover.

The committee set the next meeting for September 10, 2014

William Scarpelli made a motion to adjourn at 8:15 p.m. John Goldthwait seconded the motion. All others voted in favor.
